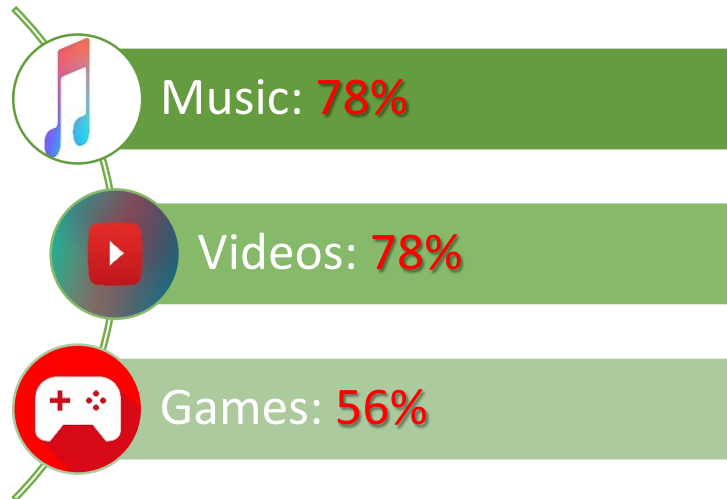


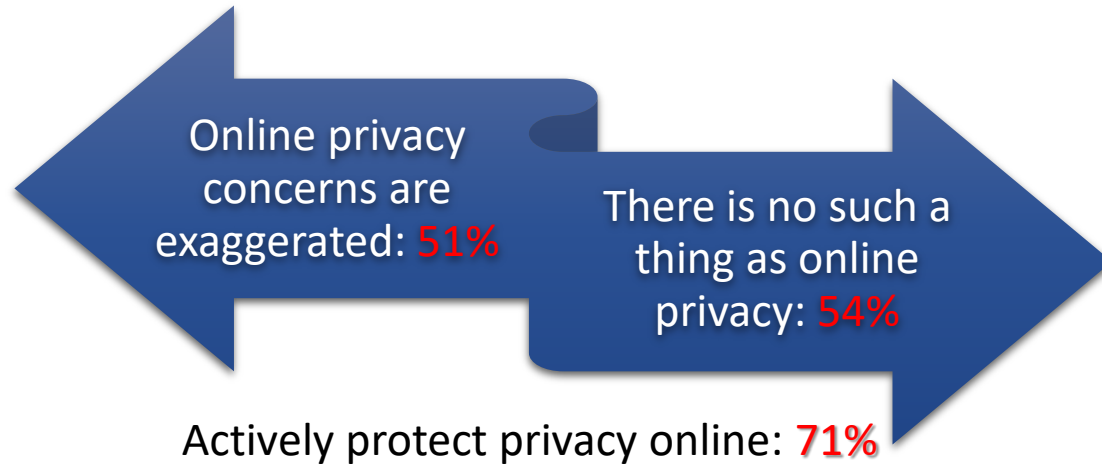
80% feel that at least half of online information is reliable
